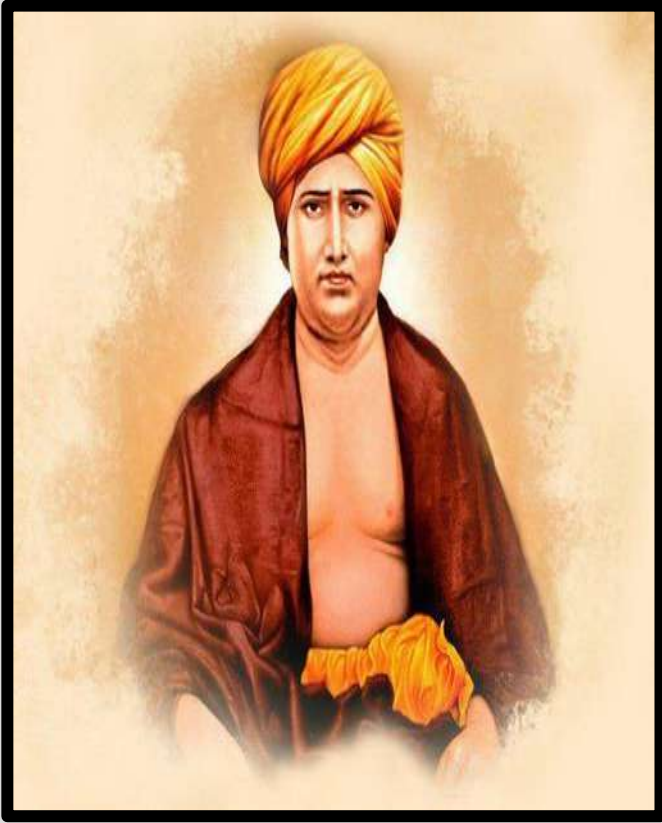

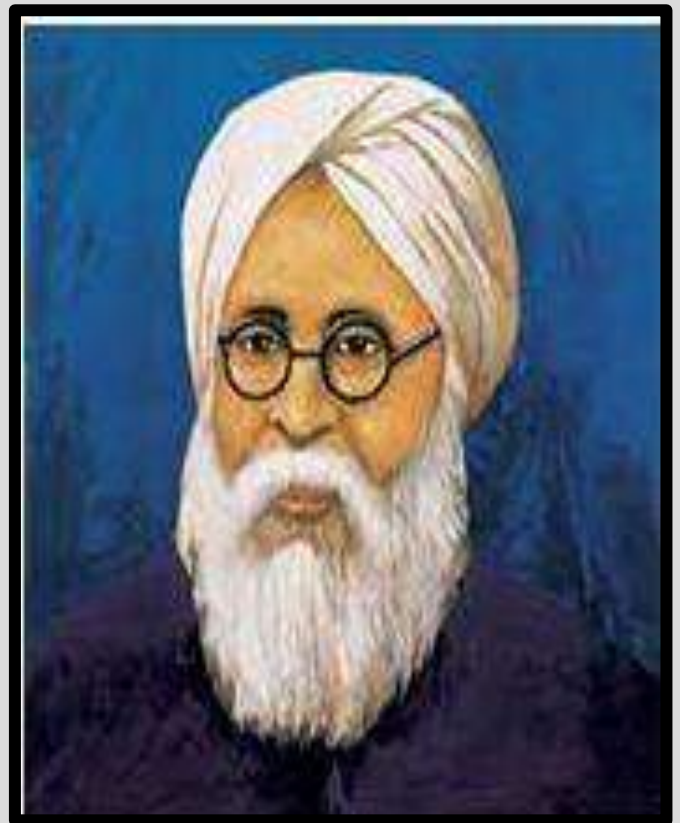

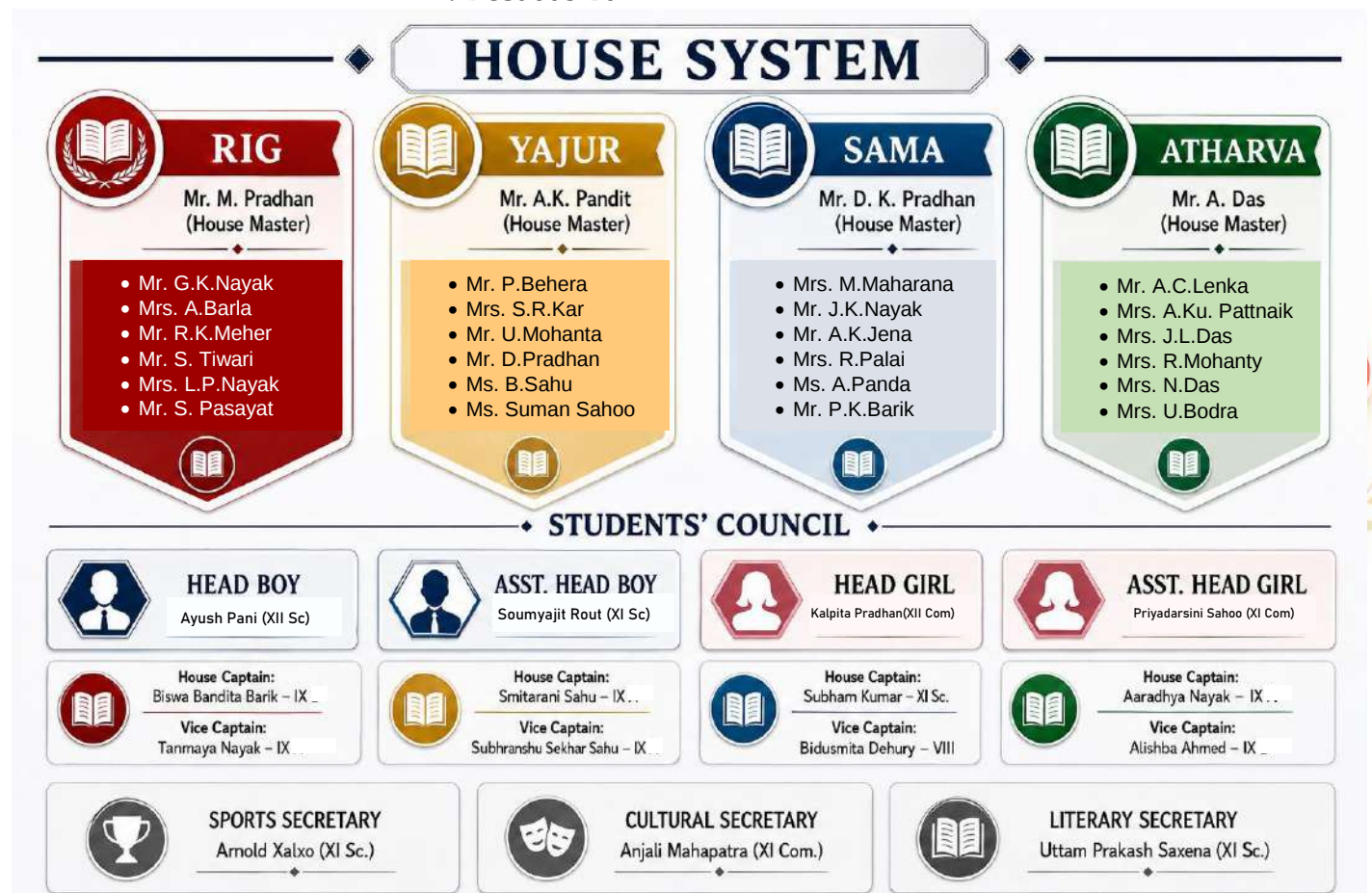
OUR HOUSE SYSTEM
