








3. YAJUR (Yellow colour) 4. ATHARVA (Green colour)



- The penalty for default of fee shall be levied as Rs.25/- of the first month, Rs.50/- for the second month and Rs.100/- for the third month. After the third month, the name of the default student(s) shall be struck off rolls and the parent has to seek re-admission of the child by paying the outstanding fees along with all their admission charges as applicable. In case, 20th day of the month happens to fall on a scheduled office Holiday/Sunday/ Sudden strike/Bandh etc. the fees shall be collected on the next working day.
- All the fees paid to the school except caution money are non-refundable and nontransferable.
